

**GAINES TOWNSHIP
ORDINANCE NUMBER 114**

An ordinance to prohibit trespassing and prowling; and to proscribe penalties for violations thereof.

THE GAINES TOWNSHIP BOARD HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. Trespassing.

- (A) It shall be unlawful for any person to enter upon the lands or premises of another without lawful authority after having been forbidden to do so by the owner or occupant, or by the agent or servant of the owner or occupant.
- (B) It shall be unlawful for any person, being upon the land or premises of another, to neglect or refuse to depart therefrom after being notified to depart by the owner or occupant, or the agent or servant of either.

Section 2. Prowling.

It shall be unlawful for any person to prowl about the private premises of any other person without authority or the permission of the owner of such premises.

Section 3. Penalty.

A person violating this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor punishable by a fine of not more than \$500.00 and/or imprisonment in the county jail for not more than 90 days.


Section 4. Effective Date.

This ordinance shall take effect 30 days after publication.



The Supervisor declared the ordinance adopted.




